Subject: Wakefield Road Booster Pump Start-up

Dear Precinct Member,

You are receiving this letter because you are connected to the new water main booster pump station. This letter is to inform you that the booster pump station start-up is anticipated to commence sometime in mid-December.

- **What to expect:** With the new booster station online, pressures within your home should range between 45psi to 85psi depending on your elevation to the station. Lower elevations will see pressures ranging from 65 psi to 85 psi, and buildings located near the water tank will see pressures ranging from 45 psi to 65 psi.
- **Why this is important:** If you have a private booster pump inside your house, it is recommended that you make provisions to disconnect or bypass the pump before the booster station comes online as the booster station may damage your private pump.
- **How does this affect the waterlines inside my house:** A typical water service pipe is rated for at least 100 psi which is more than the anticipated receiving pressures. It does not hurt to have a licensed plumber check your lines to be safe as age can affect the integrity of the pipe.
